In order to complete your registration, our office must receive a correctly completed "Registrant's Form" within 24 hours of your online registration. This form will be emailed to you upon completion of the online portion. You will not be considered registered until that form is submitted and you receive a confirmation email from tpresson@mbcb.org. Once capacity is filled, registrants will be placed on a waiting list.

For registration (Registrant Form), you will need the following for each registrant:

- Current grade in school
- T-shirt size
- # of years participated in Super Summer
- Color of school registrant will be in (see School Summary page)

IMPORTANT DOCUMENTS TO BRING TO SUPER SUMMER WHEN YOU COME:

1. Students' Medical Forms (must be signed by parent/guardian and notarized **prior** to registration)
2. **Two** completed reference forms for each student (Group leader must approve each reference before Super Summer)
3. Adult Medical Forms
4. Adult Chaperone Verification Form

ADULT CHAPERONES: Each church must send one qualified adult of the same gender (21 years or older) for each 10 youth attending. Team leaders from your church may be considered a sponsor, if they are 21 or older. Students **cannot be paired up** with another church unless they have registered with that church. **No exceptions!** The adults will participate in the Plaid School, which provides youth ministry leadership training and encouragement for adults who work with students.

IMPORTANT REGISTRATION/CHURCH INFO

CANCELLATIONS/REGISTRATION UPDATES

- All deposits are **non-refundable/non-transferrable**. This is why you should know who is eligible **before** registering.
- **After June 1st, we will NOT accept any additional registrations for any reason.** Even if you drop students, you will **not** be able to add anyone to replace them. Please do not ask for special treatment on this.
- ***NO REFUNDS** for any cancellations will be given for any reason. (*unless cancelled by MBCB*)
- **\$100 LATE FEE** will be added to the group if final payment is not received by the due date (June 27, 2024).

ADULT CHAPERONES FOR GROUPS

Every student attends must attend with a church group that meets the adult to student required ratio. Due to liability issues, we will no longer grant exceptions for students without the required adult supervision.

Each church must send one qualified adult of the same gender (21 years or older) for each 10 youth attending. Team Leaders or Servant Staff from your church may be considered a sponsor, if they are 21 or older.

Students cannot be paired up with another church unless they have actually registered with that church. NO EXCEPTIONS. If the proper ratio is not met, students from that church will not be able to attend Super Summer. The adults participate in the Plaid School, which provides bible study, youth ministry leadership training, fellowship, and encouragement.

**All churches will provide a signed statement (Adult Chaperone Verification Form) guaranteeing that all adults attending have satisfied all necessary church background checks/requirements to allow them to supervise minors.*
